

## Guardian Angels Recruit in Southeast D.C.

Washington (AP) - Members of the Guardian Angels are on patrol in Southeast Washington in response to violence at D.C. schools.

Members of the private group are also recruiting outside Ballou High School, where a student was shot and killed earlier this month.

The group was outside the school Friday along with D.C. Council members and other community leaders who are seeking \$1 million to fund community organizations in six troubled neighborhoods. Council member Kevin Chavous says he wants to see community groups like the Angels engage kids on the street.

The Angels say they're going to be walking the streets of both the neighborhoods of victim James Richardson and the alleged shooter.
