Time Warner Cable, Guardian Angels Team Up For Cyber Safety

Time Warner Cable announced Tuesday that it is teaming up with the Guardian Angels to help parents keep their kids safe online.

The company is releasing a cyber safety guide to cable and Internet customers that tells parents how to keep children away from pedophiles and predators.

“Even if they have bars on the windows and locks on the doors to keep the home invaders out, there are many people who can invade your home right through those cables, through the computer terminals, unless you are safe and secure in your usage of the computer,” said the Guardian Angels' Curtis Silwa.

“Time Warner Cable, being a major provider of Internet access here in New York City, is as concerned as most citizens about how our children are using the Internet,” said NY/NJ Time Warner Cable President Howard Szarfarc.
