

# Guardian Angels Expand To Another New Haven Neighborhood

**NEW HAVEN, Conn.** -- The Guardian Angels, who have already set up shop in Edgewood Park, and now they are expanding to another problem area.

Members of the Guardian Angels walked Winthrop Avenue eager to meet residents who were looking for change.

They said a recent string of violence on this street forced them to act.

On June 29, a 53-year-old woman was struck and killed by a stray bullet, days before that two teenagers were shot, one in the ankle and another in the face. The angels hope to stop that by keeping a close eye on the neighborhood.

The angels said it will take about a year until they can really get a handle on the area.
