East students create red alert to promote unity

More than 50 East High School students, The Points of Light Foundation, and The Volunteer Center of Brown County have created a "Red Alert: Unity in the Community" to build and maintain strong bonds between students and neighbors surrounding the school area. The program was made possible through a federal Homeland Security grant.

The students have been working in partnership with community peace officers, community builders and community advocates to provide conflict resolution, service projects and community help for current and prolonged issues.
